THE LEGENDS

Janusz Zurakowski was an extraordinary aviator long before he made the first test flight of the Avro Arrow. He was a decorated war hero. He broke speed records and invented a new maneuver called the "Zurabatic Cartwheel" while working as a test pilot in England, even before he came to Canada. He was the first person to break the speed of sound in a straight wing pure-jet aircraft without rocket power. He retired from flying to build Kartuzy Lodge in Barry's Bay, Ontario, where local residents have now built a park in his honour.

The Avro Arrow was a superior aircraft for its day and some say it still has not been equalled. It put Canada at the forefront of the aviation industry in engineering, design and performance. Due to political controversy, the program was cancelled and all of the planes and their designs were destroyed. It remains a mysterious Canadian legend.
